NOTICE OF ELECTION

1. Notice is hereby given that the day of the poll for the election of members of the Drainage Board for the several electoral districts of the above named Drainage District will, if a poll shall be necessary, be Monday, 28th October 2024.

2. The number of members of the Drainage Board (for the several electoral districts) is as follows:

8.	South Witham	1
9.	Borough of Grantham	1

3. Each candidate for election must be nominated in writing and the nomination paper must be returned to me to be received at Witham House, Meadow Lane, North Hykeham, Lincoln, LN6 9GJ not later than 12 noon on Friday, 04th October 2024.

4. An elector may not sign more nomination papers than there are members to be elected for the electoral districts of Upper Witham Internal Drainage District.

5. Nomination Forms may be obtained free of charge from Witham House, Meadow Lane, North Hykeham, Lincoln, LN6 9GJ.

6. The above does not take into account the appointment of nine members of the Drainage Board by City of Lincoln Council, four members by North Kesteven District Council, three members by South Kesteven District Council, one member by West Lindsey District Council and one member by Newark & Sherwood District Council, jointly appointed under Paragraph 6, Schedule 1 of the Land Drainage Act 1991. These members are not affected by this election.
